Mailing Declaration

I/we hereby request that you

1 send mail to my following address

2 not send mail to me/us, but rather to

by post or other means.

3 not send mail to me/us as it arises, but rather collectively at
 weekly monthly quarterly half-yearly yearly
intervals, by post or other means.

4 not send me/us any of your communications or other mail of any sort intended for me/us, but rather make such available for collection.

You may, until written notice to the contrary, surrender mail intended for me/us without receipt to any person who submits a written collection order issued by me/us: to the extent that you are obliged to verify the identity and authority of this person, you shall only be held liable for intent and gross negligence.

Uncollected mail is to be sent once a year to the most recent address given to you by me/us.

This declaration notwithstanding, you may send mail to me/us by post or other means -also as it arises - if you deem it advisable or in my/our interest.

Written communication by the bank are deemed to have been duly delivered within the ordinary course of mail, if sent to the last address of which the bank has become (par. 1, 2) or received (par. 3) notice. This does not apply if the communication is of special importance or if a written communication is returned to the bank as being undeliverable and if the customer is not responsible for this or if the bank realises that the communication has not been delivered to the customer due to a general disturbance in postal services. Dispatch of the communication will be presumed in particular if the bank has in ist possession an initialled coy of the communication in question or if such dispatch is evident from an initialled dispatch note or list.

I/we shall bear any damages or disadvantages which may arise in connection with this agreement; you shall only be held liable for intend and gross negligence.
